## ***JumpSTART Triage Train-the-Trainer Course...***

The purpose of this program is to provide an educational module related to pediatric disaster/mass casualty triage concepts and the JumpSTART algorithm. This Train-the-Trainer program targets instructor level personnel and prepares them to teach this program to healthcare professionals.

### ***Objectives...***

1. Discuss incorporating pediatrics into your disaster planning
2. Discuss unique pediatric needs/issues in a disaster situation
3. Discuss triage and the pediatric patient
4. Review the JumpSTART triage process

### ***Intended Audience...***

EMS, Hospital, School Nurse or local health department instructor level personnel (physicians, nurses, EMTs) interested in teaching pediatric disaster triage concepts and skills. After completing this program you will have the necessary tools to conduct this pediatric triage training.

### ***Note: There is no course registration fee.***

## ***Plan of Education...***

1. IDPH approved Site Code for 4 hours of education through December 2009
2. Instructional CDs will be provided upon completion of the Train-the-Trainer program. Each CD includes the following:
  - a. Lecture (approximately 1 hour in length) – PowerPoint slides with companion speaker notes
  - b. Scenarios for drills
  - c. Victims lists for drills
  - d. Appropriate color assignment for victim lists
  - e. Copy of the *EMSC Disaster Preparedness Exercises Addressing the Pediatric Population* booklet (pdf format)
  - f. The JumpSTART algorithm (hard copy and pdf)
  - g. The START algorithm (hard copy and pdf)
  - h. Training completion form (forward to EMSC for grant tracking purposes)
3. Course participants will be shown several different ways to set up drills involving the actual triage of pediatric (and some adult) patients in a disaster scenario, including methods for the purpose of formal education in a classroom type setting or drill-like purposes in the firehouse, etc.
4. Course evaluation
5. Pre and Post test
6. JumpSTART and START laminated cards will also be provided for all participants
